## Community Development in the Philippines

On the island of Leyte, a one hour flight southeast of Manila, and a community development project has been established just outside the capital city of Tacloban. At the very heart of the program, volunteers are needed to help nurses, midwives and doctors at rural health clinics, providing vital support for the local people. Depending on project needs and volunteer experience, students may assist with taking patient information and vitals, immunisations, pre-natal screening, delivering community health lessons and making house calls to rural areas
