Information and eligibility criteria for the School of Public Health:

Student must meet ALL of the criteria below:

- Be enrolled in *PUBH3003 Health Research Project*
- Must be on Good Standing status.
- Must have a Course Weighted Average of 60% or more.
- Must be eligible to obtain a visa for Thailand.
- Must demonstrate professionalism by attending and participating in workshops in this unit (80% attendance minimum).
- Complete all mandatory vaccinations.
- Have a passport with at least six months validity.
- Must be able to undertake the time commitment for any relevant preparation sessions for Go Global as well as those required by the School of Public Health
- Have the required experience, skills and attributes, as demonstrated in an interview with the Course Coordinator and Unit Coordinator.
- Submit the Fitness for placement form and be assessed as fit for placement.

PLEASE ENSURE YOU MEET THESE CRITERIA

New Colombo Program (NCP) funding grants are available for students to apply for if they are successful in being selected for this study tour. The eligibility criteria for NCP funding are (please note you must meet all of these criteria):

- Australian Citizen
- Be between 18 and 28 (inclusive) years of age as at 1 January 2019;
- Enrolled in the Bachelor of Science, Health Promotion single degree
- Must be at least the second year of your program
- Students cannot have dual citizenship or residency rights or have previously been a citizen or permanent resident of Host country
- Not be a recipient of another Australian Government funded off-shore scholarship.
- Not be a previous recipient of a New Colombo Plan Scholarship.

What you need to do:

4. You will then be notified if successful for the NCP grant
